Planting Information

Bare rooted trees are delicate and must be handled carefully. It is important to plant hedgerow trees as soon as possible. Roots must be protected prior to planting to prevent drying out or frost damage (eg kept in bags in a cool, damp location). Even a slight breeze during the planting process can dry the roots.

Spacing

Hedgerows should be planted at a density of approximately 5 to 6 plants per metre in a double staggered row or in a single row at three to four plants per metre.

Pest Protection

If you are planting in rural areas where there may be damage from rabbits, hares or voles, plants can be protected by using:

Spiral Rabbit Guards - ideal for use with most species and will expand with growth of the plant.

Shrub/tree Shelters useful for branching species such as Holly and they promote a faster growth in height.
